- Dennis and Ken attended the recent John 17 Steering Committee meeting in Tucson.
- The John 17 Weekends organization is no longer affiliated with 4Tucson.
- J17 Ministries has been formed as a covering organization for John 17 Weekends and other ministries falling out of 4Tucson, to provide tax exempt status and other support.
- John 17 Weekends is still governed by a Steering Committee as they move forward. Should they continue on the Tres Dias chartering path, they would eventually form a Secretariat.
- Anyone attending a John 17 Steering Committee meeting in Tucson as a guest must come with a purpose.
- TDI update (Time: 10 Min) Suzette, Brenda
 - Spring TDI Secretariat meeting was held in Boise, attended by Suzette, Brenda, Desiree and Peg Novak from TDCA.
 - Brenda considering becoming chair of TDI Communications Committee, will provide support for other communities' Communications/Website activities.
 - TDI getting ready for July Assembly meeting.
 - Boise Sequela only had 30 people show.
 - TDI looking to increase participation from more communities, considering restricting involvement from a single community to avoid over-representation.
 - Significant time was spent at the Idaho meeting reviewing SD Guidelines and an additional position paper is being created (Reminder Tres Dias is lay led community).
 - If you are ordained or licensed by a church or denomination, you are considered an SD.
 - SDs cannot serve as Heads, be at a Table, give a Rollo or be a Rector or Rectora.
 - Reminder of Cloistered weekends during the spouse talk, only the spouse should be present, no extra support folks of the spouse's gender allowed
 - TDI Assessment Fees are used to help w/ International Communities (among other things).
 - Looking at providing support for communities to reach out to local churches possible position on local Secretariats.
 - A partnership is being formed between TDI and Kairos (Adult Prison Ministry) to share information regarding our joint ministries.
 - TDI has attempted to address phones on weekend issues in a Policy paper.
